Dear Members of the School Community,

With reference to the circular **ISAM/ CR/ADM/2023- '24/033** dated **03 September 2023**, we would like to reiterate the following **traffic guidelines** for your adherence.

1. Speed Limits:

- Please maintain a maximum speed of **20 km/h** while driving on the school road.
- Reduce your speed to **10 km/hr** when entering and driving within the parking area.

2. Safety First:

- Please exert the utmost care and vigilance when driving, always considering the safety and security of both students inside the vehicle and those in the vicinity.

3. Designated Parking:

- All stakeholders are required to park their vehicles in the designated parking area, **located behind the school ground** (near the Kho Kho court and behind the Multipurpose Hall).
- For evening programs, proper lighting facilities will be arranged in the parking areas, and dedicated supporting staff will be deployed to assist in identifying the designated parking areas.

4. Reverse parking

- We kindly encourage all stakeholders to embrace reverse parking to alleviate traffic jams. Reverse parking allows drivers to have better visibility when exiting a parking spot. This reduces the risk of accidents with pedestrians or oncoming vehicles, making the school premises a safer environment for everyone. Your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated and it contributes to smoother traffic flow in school premises.

5. Student Entry and Exit:

Students must enter and exit the school premises through gates **numbered 2, 3, and 4 only**. **Parking on the road** & slowing down of vehicles is strictly prohibited at Gate No 1 as **it disrupts the orderly movement of vehicles** and to avoid causing discomfort **or inconvenience to the nearby residents**.

6. Gate No. 1 Access:

- Gate No. 1 will be accessible from **8:30 am onwards** and should be exclusively used for fee payments, TC/admissions inquiries, and related matters.

6. ROP Traffic Guidelines:

- Strictly follow the traffic guidelines issued by the **Royal Oman Police (ROP)**, Sultanate of Oman, while navigating in the school vicinity and surrounding areas.

We sincerely appreciate your cooperation in adhering to these traffic management guidelines.
